Hand Disinfection



Dear visitors,

We care very much about our patients' safety.

To avoid transmitting infections at the hospital, adhering to hygiene measures plays a major role with hand hygiene being the most important factor.

We kindly ask you to adhere to the hygiene measures in order to protect your relatives and other patients. Please coordinate with the nursing staff on the ward in advance when visiting with children.

Here is a comprehensive list of the most important information on how to disinfect your hands:

Where?

• Please always disinfect your hands directly in the patient's room.

When?

- When entering or leaving the room.
- As well as after blowing your nose, sneezing or coughing.
- If you have a cold, please ask for a surgical mask and wear it covering your mouth and nose.

How?

- Take 2 to 3 portions of hand disinfectant from the dispenser.
- Evenly and thoroughly distribute the disinfectant over the entire surface of your hands and wrists until the fluid is absorbed into your skin.
