Protective Clothing



Dear visitors,

We care very much about our patients' safety.

To avoid transmitting infections at the hospital, adhering to hygiene measures, hand hygiene in particular, is of utmost importance.

Additional measures have to be taken if a patient has to be isolated in order to prevent the spread of germs.

These protection measures depend on the type of germ and its transmission path. Thus, the patient will, for example, be accommodated in a private (single bed) room and the respective protection clothing (gown, if need be, gloves or mouth / nose protection) has to be worn in the event of contact.

Therefore, we kindly ask you to adhere to the following guidelines in order to protect yourself as well as your relatives.

Please contact the nursing staff if you have any questions regarding protective clothing or hygiene procedures. If desired, we will gladly arrange an individual hygiene counseling for you.

Before entering the patient's room, please

- · announce your visit to the staff
- take as few personal items as possible into the room. For hygienic reasons it is not permitted to place personal items on shelf spaces, floors or window sills in the room. Please ask the staff for available storage options.
- have the staff show you how to put on and dispose of protective clothing to be worn and how to carry out hand disinfection.
- always disinfect your hands before putting on the protective clothing.
- don't forget to fasten the gown in the back.

Before leaving the patient's room, please

- take off the worn protective clothing in the room and dispose of it in the provided receptacle.
- immediately disinfect your hands prior to leaving the room.
