

## Guideline for poster presenters at the ESHMS 2026

Dear presenters,

Thank you very much for your contribution to this year's ESHMS conference in Hamburg. Below, we have put together a few points to help you prepare for the congress and to ensure a seamless experience for everyone involved. All sessions will be supported by a chair as well as technical staff.

As a presenter, please keep the following points in mind:

There will be two parallel poster sessions. After the sessions, all posters will be moved to another location, where they will be kept on display during the conference. Please note that posters not removed by the end of the conference will be taken down by the conference centre staff and will not be stored or returned to the authors.

- Poster mounting will be possible upon your arrival.
- You will find your poster board number in the final programme.
- The size of the poster should be A0 (841 x 1188 mm), and the orientation must be vertical (portrait).
- Please be in the location 10 to 15 minutes prior to session start.
- In the 60-minute poster sessions, each presentation is allotted 5 minutes, followed by 3 minutes for discussion and a short transition to the next poster.
- Shortly before the end of your presentation, the session chair will signal that you should begin to wrap up.
- You may use QR codes to link your poster to additional material, videos, or other online resources.
- If you wish, you may add a photo of yourself to the poster. This helps participants identify and approach you for discussions.
