1. Recruitment of new iSTAR Advanced Clinician Scientist scholars

Three further excellent iSTAR scholars have been recruited within the second round of applications. **Dr. Julia Pagel** is going to start in May 2023. She is interested in the "Influence of gut microbiota on immunometabolic function in juvenile idiopathic arthritis" and works for the Department of Pediatrics. **Dr. Fabian Braun** is going to start in October 2023. He works for the III. Department of Medicine. His research focuses on the "Extracellular vesicles in Glomerulonephritis – Mediators of the epithelial - immune cell axis and untapped diagnostic resource". **Dr. Johannes Hartl** is going to join the programme in the middle of 2023. He is interested in the "Common and distinct pathogenic mechanism in autoimmune hepatitis and lupus related to anti-DNA antibodies". He works for the I. Department of Medicine.

Furthermore, two associated members were selected. **Dr. Angelique Hölzemer**, I. Department of Medicine, working on "NK cell receptor diversity as a determinant of clinical outcome in virus infection" and **Dr. Nicola Tomas**, who works in the III. Department of Medicine and investigates mechanisms and innovative therapies in antibody-mediated autoimmune diseases.

The first <u>iSTAR Retreat</u> took place as a hybrid-meeting at the Dorint Hotel in Hamburg on Tuesday, 4th October 2022. In addition to presentations by the iSTAR candidates, coaching sessions were held by an external coach and the iSTAR mentors.
